How to use this map:

The map is marked with numbered circles, which show the locations of the numbered marker posts. A description of the location of each post is shown in the table below. Each control post also has a two letter code, which you can copy into the space on the table.

The start of the course is marked with a triangle, and the finish is marked with a double circle. Both the start and the finish are on the same marker post. How many posts can you visit before your time runs out?

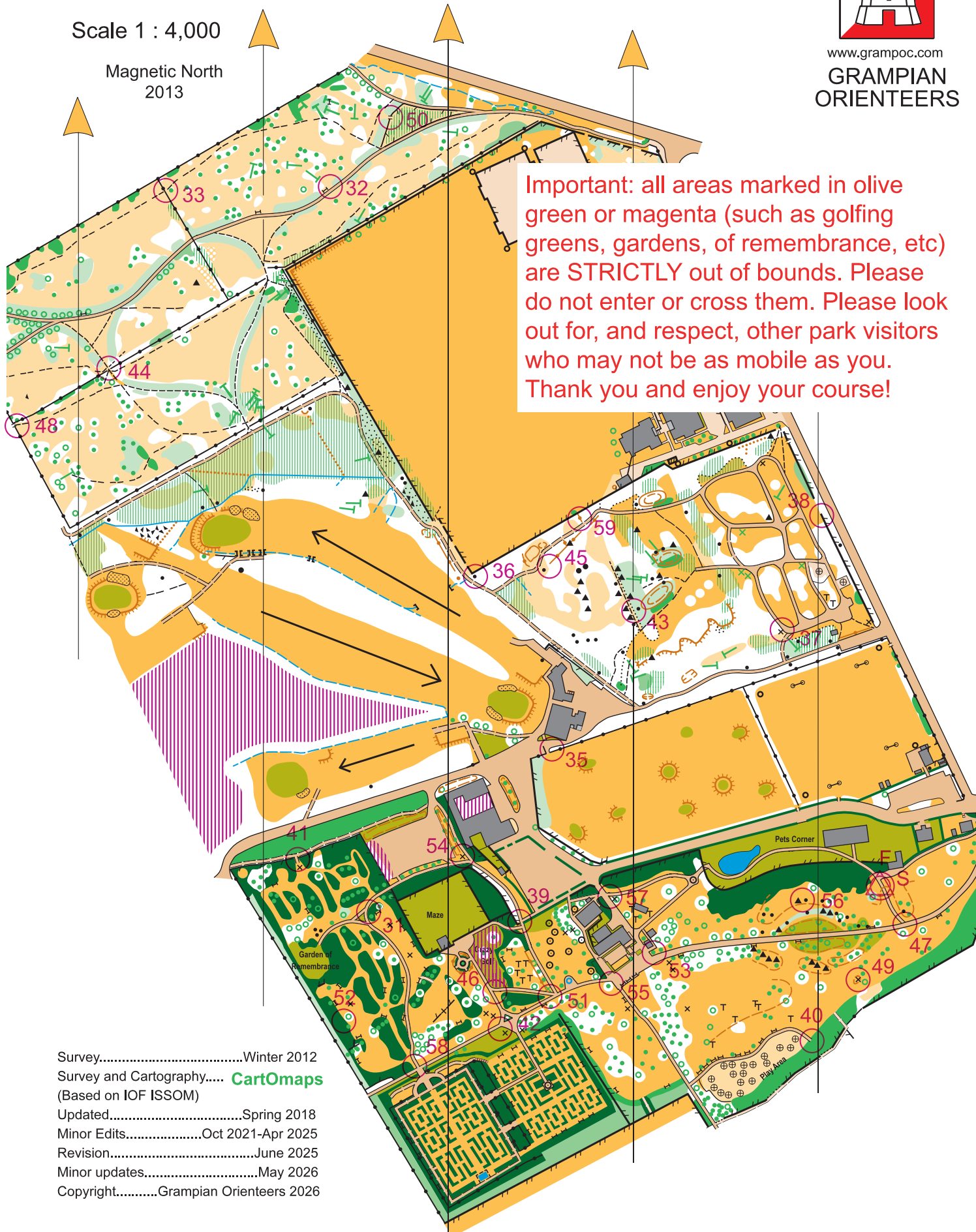
